We are especially delighted that Dr Tan is still an active contributor to the University of Adelaide.

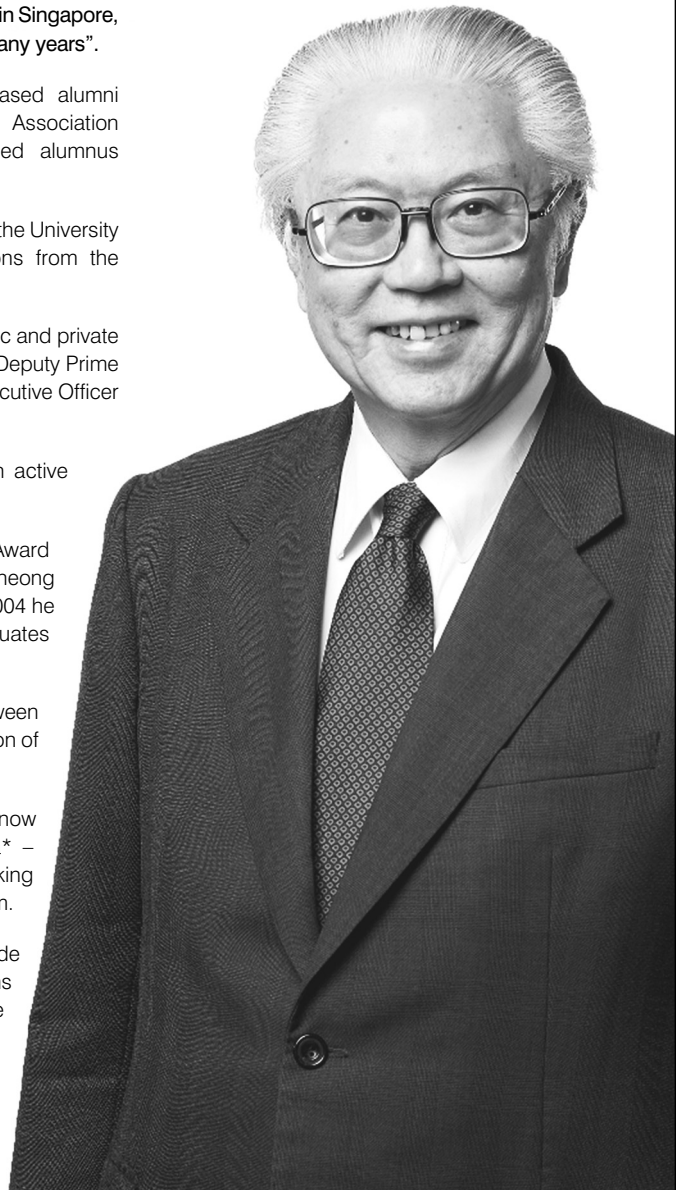
