Now, more than ever, we are reminded of how precious peace and safety are. The Russian invasion of the Ukraine highlights the importance of states and people coming together to stand up for what is right and just. This has been a solemn reminder that we must learn from the past and step away from the horrors of war.

It has only been 80 years since the Fall of Singapore, the day the Malaya Command surrendered to the invading Japanese Army. The Australian High Commission of Singapore attended profound dawn commemoration of this important anniversary at Kranji War Cemetery on the 15th of February. Singapore and Japan's joint efforts at reconciliation and commitment to ongoing peace were a focal point of the morning.



The Singapore High Commission in Canberra said, "That Australian soldiers defended Singapore even before we became an independent nation, is a fact which entwines our histories in a deep sense of gratitude which endures to present day."

Australia and Singapore's deep ties include a shared understanding of the tragedy of war and a mutual belief in the preservation of sovereignty and all countries' right to exist.

As ANZAC day approaches and we continue to reflect upon the losses of wars past, our thoughts are with the Ukrainian people for whom this pain is all too immediate.

The New Zealand High Commission, in conjunction with the Australian High Commission, will be hosting the 2022 ANZAC Day Dawn Service. The Service will be held at the Kranji War Cemetery on Monday 25 April 2022 commencing at 6.30am.



The new campus - Newcastle Australia Institute of Higher Education (formerly known as UON Singapore), will be the University's hub in the Asia Pacific region.

The campus was officially opened by the University of Newcastle's alumnus Dr Khaw Boon Wan, Chairman of SPH Media Trust, the Australian High Commissioner His Excellency William Hodgman and the Vice-Chancellor of The University of Newcastle, Professor Alex Zelinsky, AO.

At the official launch ceremony, the University of Newcastle's distinguished alumnus, former minister Dr Khaw expressed that the Singapore alumni has had the privilege and opportunity to take part in Singapore's nation building and that he is happy to see the University grow externally, with a full-fledged campus in Singapore. He said, "I started the relationship with the University of Newcastle in 1973, 49 years ago. It's not long for a nation or an institution, but it's long enough for us to have personally experienced the transformation in our lives, our country, and our university."

The Australia High Commissioner, His Excellency Willian Hodgman asserted that the University has established its credibility in the region for higher education and it has now demonstrated its commitment with the opening of the impressive premises. The Vice-Chancellor Professor Alex Zelinsky expressed that Singapore is one of Asia's most advanced hubs for education, research and innovation and that the University is delighted to strengthen its presence in this region. This new entity is expected to be a strategic gateway that provides opportunities to connect students and researchers with businesses and industries in the region and beyond. This is also supported by around 7500 University of Newcastle alumni in Singapore who continue to build strong links between Singapore and Australia. The Vice-Chancellor further highlighted that the launch of the new Singapore campus demonstrates the University's commitment in building strong regional partnerships and delivering globally engaged and collaborative education and research, which is a focus of its "Looking Ahead" strategic plan.

The University of Newcastle started to deliver its programs in Singapore in 2002. More than 6,000 students in Singapore have graduated with degrees from the University of Newcastle.

With the new premise at the National Library Building, Newcastle Australia Institute of Higher Education will be introducing post-graduate programs in the areas of Business Psychology, Information Technology, Health Economics and Management and Policy, Data Science and Special and Inclusive Education, thereby aiming to play an essential role in the Asia Pacific region representing the parent University.
