In recent years, many of us have come to the end of the year unable to spend time with loved ones and readying ourselves for what uncertainties the new year will bring.

It is with great joy that as we approach the end of 2022. We have seen the lifting of restrictions, opening of borders and renewed connection between family, friends, and our two nations. It has been wonderful to reconnect through in-person events this year.

2022 has also been marked with extraordinary and devastating events, like the ongoing military coup in Myanmar and Russia's invasion of Ukraine, but it has also sprung new hope and deepened connections.

Australia's relationship with Singapore is one of our closest. We trust each other. We like each other. We visit often. We study together. We're there for each other in good times and in tough times. The Australian High Commission acknowledges Singapore's Armed Forces have worked alongside the Australian Defence Forces during some tough times for us - the Operation Bushfire Assist in 2020 and Flood Assists in 2022. Meet our multi-talented dancer who suffers from Tourette Syndrome

If you were at our 67th anniversary gala dinner, you would have watched Raymond Lau Poo Seng perform his piece at the AAS Got Talent. Many of us were in awe of his performance, and he won the first prize that night. Little did we know that Raymond suffers from Tourette Syndrome and has stage 3 throat cancer.

We only found out later that Raymond is a cancer patient and decided to seek his permission to share his story.

Raymond graduated from the University of Tasmania in 1995 with an advanced degree of Bachelor of Fine Arts. He is currently an artist at a non-profit organisation, ART:DIS, where he mentors and donates his works. He wished to assist and empower artists with disabilities to confidently express themselves through the arts so that they could make a sustainable living from their abilities.

During his free time, Raymond would cycle or dance to keep fit and stay active. He used to be a martial artist too and was in the lion dance troupe both as a performer and an instructor. He started dancing at the age of 22. He signed up for dance classes because he wanted to build his confidence back

We admire his enthusiasm for life (if you stayed for the last segment of the gala, you would have seen Raymond's energetic performance that night). He shared that the reason he has decided to live his life to the fullest is because it is his way of being grateful for the life he has.

In addition to having Tourette Syndrome, Raymond was given a stage in 2021. He was informed that persons with his diagnosis often live for five years. This led Raymond to make the decision to live his life to the fullest, regardless of how many years he had

James Cook University, Singapore PhD candidate joins **UA Global Summit 2022**



PhD candidate Catherine Toh contributed to the 'Student Mobility and Partnerships' panel discussion, alongside her role as a member of the UA judging panel.

The Global Undergraduate Award (UA) is a prestigious global academic awards programme that serves to recognise the world's leading creative thinkers and problem solvers through their undergraduate coursework. The programme also aims to share their work with a global audience, and connects students across cultures and disciplines. This year, UA received close to 3000 submissions from students across 73 countries.

The top-performing students and recent graduates from around the world are invited to the annual UA Global Summit — a unique three-day event — for networking, discussion, and celebration. This year, the event took place on 6-9 November.

PhD (Health) candidate from James Cook University (JCU) in Singapore, Catherine Toh, was invited to contribute as a member of the UA judging panel. In addition, Catherine also contributed to a panel discussion on "Student Mobility and Partnerships". The panel discussion focused on the role of partnerships in enhancing student outcomes, building a global presence, and strengthening the institutional brand.

Catherine is currently pursuing her higher degree research at JCU in Singapore. Her research project intends to explore, over a duration of 18 months, how trainee counsellors in Singapore make sense of their hindering self-awareness (HSA) experiences or when their self-awareness becomes overwhelming to manage during counsellor training. This research aims to investigate HSA and the perceived influence on trainee counsellors' counselling self-efficacy and supervisory working alliance.

Catherine shares, "I consider myself a 'mobile student' largely due to |CU's learning environment, and the strong support I have received in my academic endeavours in addition to my personal aspirations. It was a wonderful opportunity to be a part of the panel discussion, learning alongside international scholars, and to share my own JCU experiences in the discussion. The success of the UA Global Summit underscores the value of partnerships in enhancing student mobility which is one of the contributing factors to students' overall well-being and academic outcomes."



James Cook Academy strengthens ties with Marshall Cavendish Education to develop IT and Soft Skills online courses for K-12 educators



James Cook Academy and Marshall Cavendish Education have signed a Memorandum of Understanding to enhance collaboration.

On 11 November 2022, James Cook Academy (JCA) signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with Marshall Cavendish Education (MCE) with the objective of offering a suite of short online learning courses through JCA's wholly-owned subsidiary, Eagle Infotech, in the areas of information technology and soft skills for K-12 educators outside of Singapore. The online short courses will be hosted on MCEduHub for Professional Development (PD) — MCE's 24/7 learning portal designed for educators to access certified courses, anytime and anywhere.

In 2021, James Cook University in Singapore established James Cook Academy which in turn acquired Eagle Infotech for Continuing Professional Development.

On the other hand, Marshall Cavendish Education is a global education solutions provider dedicated to nurturing the joy of learning and preparing students and educators for the future. MCE's educational content and solutions seeks to simplify learning and fit the needs of schools, educators, students, and parents. They setup their professional development portal — MCEduHub for Professional Development in 2019.

The partnership was inked on 11 November by Mr Andrew Chew, Chief Executive Officer of James Cook Academy and Chairman of Eagle Infotech and Mr. Lim Soon Jinn, Head of Digital Solutions and Commercial of MCE.

The signing was witnessed by Mrs Nicola Hodgman, Associate Director Special Projects, James Cook University in Singapore and Mr Yeoh Cheng Poh, Head of MCE.

Mr Lim Soon Jinn, Head of Digital Solutions and Commercial shared, "IT and Soft skills have been growing in demand not only in the corporate world but in the education sector too. The use of technologies in education has helped improve efficiency in teaching and learning. Good soft skills such as effective communication has also helped teachers to create a better connection with students, parents and their fellow teachers."

"We believe that our collaboration with James Cook Academy will add to the variety of our online courses that are readily accessible on MCEduHub for PD and make affordable for educators around the region."

Mr Andrew Chew, Chief Executive Officer of James Cook Academy and Chairman of Eagle Infotech, said, "Through this collaboration, we look forward to supporting schools by equipping their staff with relevant skills to stay on the cutting edge. We remain steadfast in our mission to educate and empower the current and future workforce through our high-quality short courses."

Lendlease continues outstanding performance for GRESB sustainability rankings





Globally, Lendlease continues to demonstrate leadership in sustainability, reflected in all 17 funds achieving high Global Real Estate Sustainability Benchmark (GRESB) scores in 2022. In each of the four regions in which Lendlease operates – Australia, Asia, Europe and the Americas – at least one fund achieved a number one ranking. LREIT has attained the highest rating of 5 stars for its ESG performance for the past three years since its listing on the Singapore Stock Exchange in 2019.

GTI Quota from 15,000 places to under 8,500, and now only 5,000 places available



The Australian government has reduced the quota substantially in the **October migration planning levels**. Nevertheless, the quota for 2022/23 is on par with the pre-COVID quota for the global talent programme (2019/2020). So, what does that mean for potential candidates in Singapore?

This means **only the more** *I* **most exceptional and truly outstanding candidates will be invited** to apply for the global talent visa. We can expect that the GTI programme will only become more and more competitive, and the level of evidence required to substantiate claims of international achievement will increase.

We also note that **Ministerial Direction 100** provides that the global talent visa will no longer be processed on a priority basis, with the government giving priority to general skilled migration (particularly with those occupations in education and healthcare sectors); as well as employer nominated visa programmes (particularly for accredited sponsors and those who are in designated regional areas).

However, our interpretation is that although the global talent visa application processing won't be fast-tracked, as long as the candidate had received an invitation, there is still a very strong chance they will be granted the global talent visa, provided they are able to demonstrate their achievements will be prominent and current at the time of the visa processing (despite of the passage of time).
