A lifelong learner, he has also been accepted into the University College London (UCL) to pursue a Doctorate in Business Administration (Health), continuing a distinguished academic journey spanning management, law, and public health.



Globally, Edmund serves as an Advisory Board Member of the World Patients Alliance (WPA) and as a Member of the WPA Asia Pacific Regional Steering Committee, driving regional collaboration to strengthen patient voices across the Asia Pacific. He also contributes actively to GlobalSkin as a Membership Committee Member and an Executive Member of the GlobalSkin South-East Asia and Western Pacific Regional Network Working Group, ensuring that regional perspectives are represented in global health dialogues.



In addition, he is an IFPA (International Federation of Psoriasis Associations) Global Psoriasis Ambassador, amplifying awareness of psoriatic disease worldwide. In Singapore, Edmund is the General Secretary of the Psoriasis Association of Singapore, where he leads patient engagement and advocacy initiatives.

Professionally, Edmund has over 25 years of leadership experience in business development, marketing, and management across the Asia-Pacific and Middle East. He also teaches as an Associate Lecturer with James Cook University Singapore and Curtin University Singapore, alongside other institutions, where he inspires students in international business, strategy, and sustainability. In recognition of his teaching excellence and dedication to student learning, he was awarded the SIM Teaching Excellence Award in 2025 by the Singapore Institute of Management.

Edmund is widely recognised for two frameworks he developed: TAQA (Timely, Affordable, Quality Access), which calls for healthcare equity, and the 4Es (Education, Exposure, Exploitation, Exploration), which guides personal and community empowerment.

In 2025, Edmund was elected Head of Partnerships for the University of Newcastle Singapore Alumni Chapter, where he is dedicated to strengthening alumni connections, fostering collaborations, and creating opportunities to inspire and empower graduates.

Known as a 10x Productive Chronic Patient, Edmund embodies how resilience, lifelong learning, and collaboration can transform personal challenges into platforms for global change.
